We are pleased to inform you of your child's participation in VmathLive®, an online math program designed to strengthen your child's skills and understanding of math. VmathLive offers interactive and motivating math activities to give your child the opportunity to practice and apply essential math concepts and skills needed for success in math.

VmathLive is a component of the Vmath® and TransMath intervention curricula, or it can be used as a supplement to the math program being taught in your child's class. It can be accessed from any computer with an Internet connection at school, at home, at the library, or in any after-school setting.

This letter introduces the benefits of VmathLive and encourages parents and guardians to take an active role in their child's math progress. First, encourage your child to use VmathLive at least three times per week and balance the time between—Learn and Play.
